Kedleston Country House Tractor Run Terms & Conditions

Only the named Driver & Vehicle on the Application Form can drive in the run.

All information provided by the applicants must be factual and up to date; meaning that they are legally allowed to take part.

Drivers are responsible for their vehicle at all times before, during and after the event.

The Driver will have adequate experience of driving their vehicle safely on the roads.

The Driver must provide their valid UK Driving Licence at check in and will have it to hand.

Check in will require vehicles to line up in order of arrival, on one side only, along Inn Lane. Please enter Inn Lane from The Common Lane junction (at Park Nook Farm), facing up to Kedleston Country House.

Vehicles are only to arrive at Kedleston Country House (KCH) from 3.45pm onwards and no later than 4.45pm.

Park in single file. Please turn engines off. No turning/overtaking. Stay with your vehicle.

Drivers are to park safely on Inn Lane and later if returning to KCH garden/carparks.

Drivers are to be aware and mindful of pedestrians (especially small children) when driving and parking their vehicles before, during and after the event.

Drivers are to respect & comply with the instructions of the Event Stewards and organisers.

All passengers must be registered with the Stewards at check in and pay £10pp. Correct Cash payments only – no change can be given. All payments go to Ben's Den.

All passengers are the responsibility of the driver and participate at their own risk. The Organisers accept no responsibility for passengers. They must only be carried if it is legal and safe to do so.

No animals are allowed at the event or are to travel in the convoy.

All participants will raise as much funds as possible for only the designated charity: The Ben Parker Trust Fund (Charity Number 1106708). All proceeds raised from the run will go to them. Any other donations/cash collected must be handed to the bar at KCH by 11pm on the night of the event.

Drivers will abide by the Highway Code; all road traffic laws and the Road Traffic Act 2004.

Drivers (and their passengers) will respect and be courteous to the Event Stewards and other participants, road users, pedestrians, and spectators.

Drivers will pull over to let other road users pass if it is safe and legal to do so.

Drivers will maintain safe speeds and will stay in convoy, following the designated route and lead vehicle.

All lights and decorations will be securely and safely attached to every part of the vehicle.

Decorations & lights will not overhang the vehicle or be a hazard to spectators and other road users.

Drivers must be easy to identify. They should securely and clearly display their Run Number (on the Drivers' and passenger door) in the waterproof wallet.

All social media posts regarding the event must maintain the positive ethos and reputation of the event, KCH and Ben's Den.

Should participants fail to comply with any of the above or should they bring the event/KCH/Ben's Den into conflict or disrepute in any way; they will be asked to leave the event/venue (without reason or refund) immediately.

Drivers are to pay a £25 admin fee to participate and will pay it at the same time as processing their application. The payment will only be processed if your application is successful. Those not, will be voided and data destroyed in line with data protection.

Participation is only at the discretion of the run organisers and Ben's Den. An application does not mean participation is guaranteed. Successful applicants will be notified by the Organisers. Allocated places can be withdrawn at any time.
